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

The Business Management and Computer Science students got the opportunity to visit the ND-9 Studio on 28th August '21, supervised by our BM Teacher, Mr. Shaam Deshmukh. We all were so elated to be able to meet face-to-face and see the application of our knowledge in the real world.

Being a Business Management student, there are always so many business aspects that intrigue me which I wanted to see up close, but never had the chance to. However, this industrial visit gave me the opportunity to explore and learn more about business in the real-world such as marketing, collaboration, budget allocation, human resource management, the impact of technology, etc.

We visited the ND-9 Studio which is a digital cinema company based in Pune. All of us explored the entire studio, right from the editing room to the recording studio. It was so nice to see the passion for work and cinema, and how each person had so many learnings to share. Before this visit, I would sometimes overlook the different stages in every single business activity and focused more on the outcome. But after hearing the employees at the studio, I started to look at things in a more open-minded way to consider that there are so many minute activities that go into a business, and each one of them is significant in their own way.




